



Welcome to Eugene T. Mahoney State Park!

Thank you for considering Mahoney State Park for your event. We provide quality service whether you want to spend the day enjoying the many activities provided by the park or you are looking for a place to hold your meeting. Our accommodations include meeting rooms, cabins, lodge rooms, picnic shelters, restaurant dining and catering.

Located just 30 minutes from Omaha or Lincoln, Mahoney State Park and the surrounding attractions are well-worth a visit any time of the year.

ACCOMMODATIONS *[More detailed information is located within this packet.]*

Fifty-seven modern housekeeping cabins, secluded on wooded ridge tops, are available year-round and may be reserved, in advance, up to one year to the date. Complete with central air and heat, cabins are furnished with linens, tableware and basic cookware. All cabins have a fireplace, satellite TV, refrigerator, range, outdoor deck, and grill.

Peter Kiewit Lodge offers forty guest rooms, all with heat/AC, satellite TV, wireless internet, coffee maker, dorm refrigerator, microwave, telephone, private bath and at least two queen-size beds in each room. Sixteen have sleeping lofts and fireplaces; twenty-four have walk-out decks that overlook the Park or the Platte River.

Camping areas offer 150 spacious, hard-surfaced pads situated amid mature shade trees. All sites have 30 and 50 amp electrical hook-ups. Drinking water and modern shower/latrine buildings are conveniently located. A coin-operated laundry is located in the shower building in the Little Creek camp area.

GROUP FUNCTIONS / CONFERENCE FACILITIES

Group and conference facilities for 12 to 200 people may be reserved up to 12 months to the date in advance. Rental information and room sizes are listed on the following pages. Please call the Group Functions office at (402) 944-2901 for additional information and booking.

The Crete Carrier Riverview Lodge is a year-round facility that can accommodate weddings, special events, conferences, and business meetings for up to 300 people depending on room set-up. We also have a covered Pavilion for your summer company picnic accommodating from 200 to several thousand people.

Catering is available to the meeting rooms, picnic shelters, Open-Air Pavilion, and Crete Carrier Riverview Lodge.

Owen Marina serves snacks & drinks during the summer and the camp store at the Marina carries ice, basic groceries and camping supplies.

The Activity Center has a concession stand serving hot dogs, Valentino’s pizza, beverages, and other selections. Pizza delivery is available to lodge rooms and cabins when the Activity Center is open.

The Family Aquatic Center features a large selection of concession items as well.

PARK ACTIVITIES



Memorial Day through Labor Day, the Park activities include the Richard L Coyne **Swimming Complex** (featuring a wave pool, water slides, Olympic size swimming pool, and aqua play area) with a capacity of 1,100 people; **Owen Marina** is the location for 4-person paddleboats; horseback riding at John Wayne **Stables**; the **Golf Shack** offers miniature golf and a driving range. *Open year-round* is also the **Craft Center** and **Activity Center** – a large indoor playground for kids of all ages along with the tallest indoor rock climbing wall. The Kountze Memorial **Theater** has Melodramas in the summer and a variety of plays in the winter. There is also a 3-mile long, 10’ wide, concrete hiking/biking path around the Park as well as hiking trails through the woods.

Winter activities include **ice skating** and a **sledding hill**, weather permitting.


There is also a **fishing lake**, a 70’ tall **observation tower**, **tennis courts**, **children’s playgrounds**, **softball diamond**, **disc golf course** and other activities. (See enclosed for details.)

NEBRASKA PARK ENTRY PERMITS

A valid Park Entry Permit is required for all vehicles entering the Park. In State Fees are **\$7.00** per day per vehicle or **\$35.00** for an annual permit. Out of State Fees are **\$14.00** per day per vehicle or **\$70.00** for an annual permit. Permits are available at the gate, in the Administration Building and Peter Kiewit Lodge front desk. Arrangements can be made through Group Functions to place a sign-in sheet at the gate for your guests and billed to your company or group after your event.

WELCOME!

You’re welcome year-round at Eugene T. Mahoney State Park! Remember, a valid park entry permit is required for all vehicles entering the park. Have an enjoyable visit and please ask any park employee if you need help or have a question.

FISHING - Fishing is permitted on both Owen Marina Baright Lake and CenturyLink Lake. Special regulations apply. A pamphlet outlines regulations, hours and limits. Trout are stocked in CenturyLink Lake during fall and winter only. Please abide by all regulations and enjoy your fishing experience.

PETS - Please keep pets leashed and attended at all times when on the park grounds. Please, no animals, except service dogs, are allowed in Kiewit Lodge or any other public buildings.

HIKES and BIKES - Six miles of hiking trails wind through the park, mostly amid the oak stands between Kiewit and Crete Carrier Riverview lodges. A nature trail loop near Kiewit Lodge identifies common trees and shrubs. Paved trails connect Owen Marina, Giger Waterway, James Conservatory and the Family Aquatic Center. Bikers, please ask at the park office for trail routes.

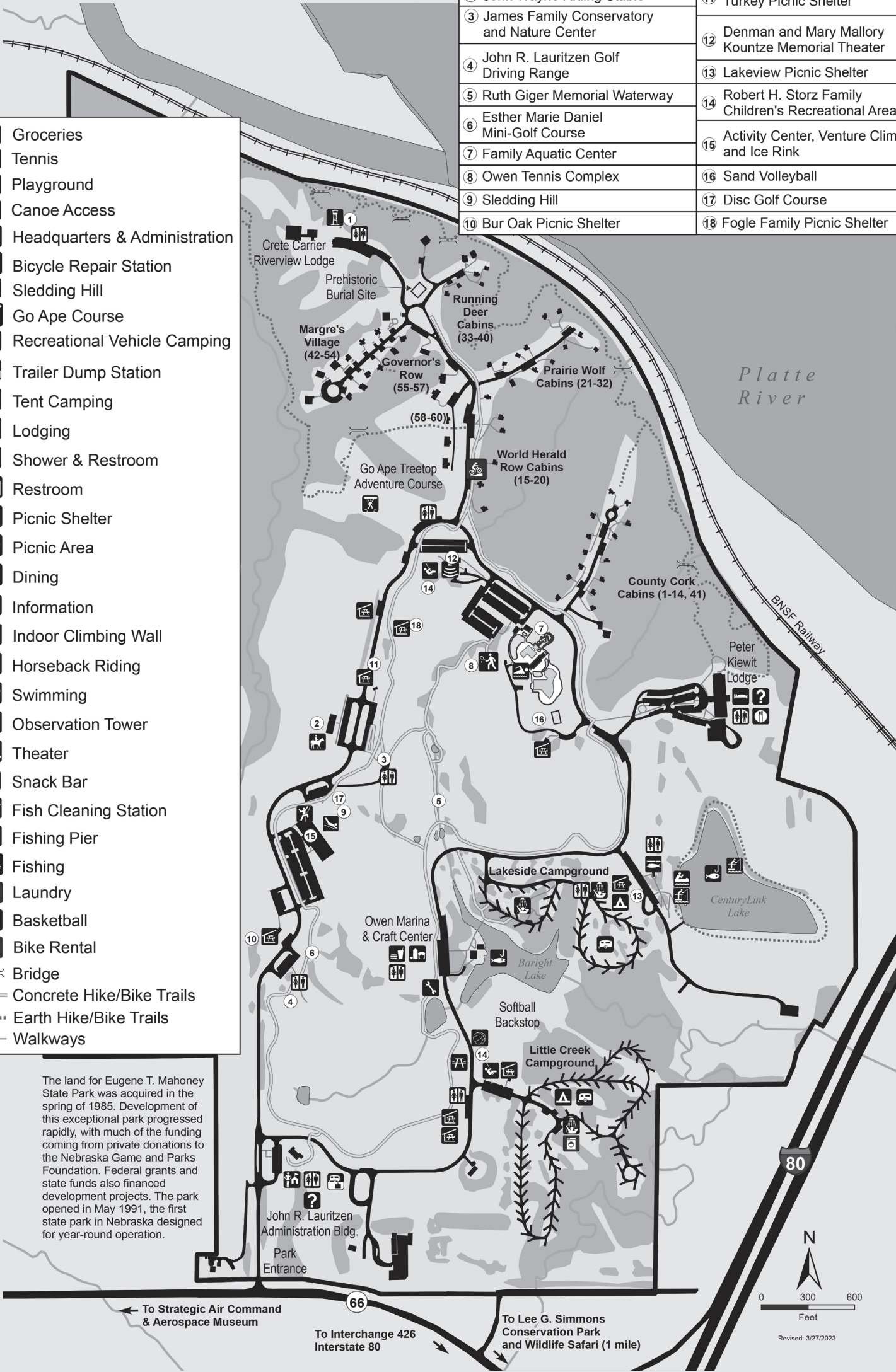

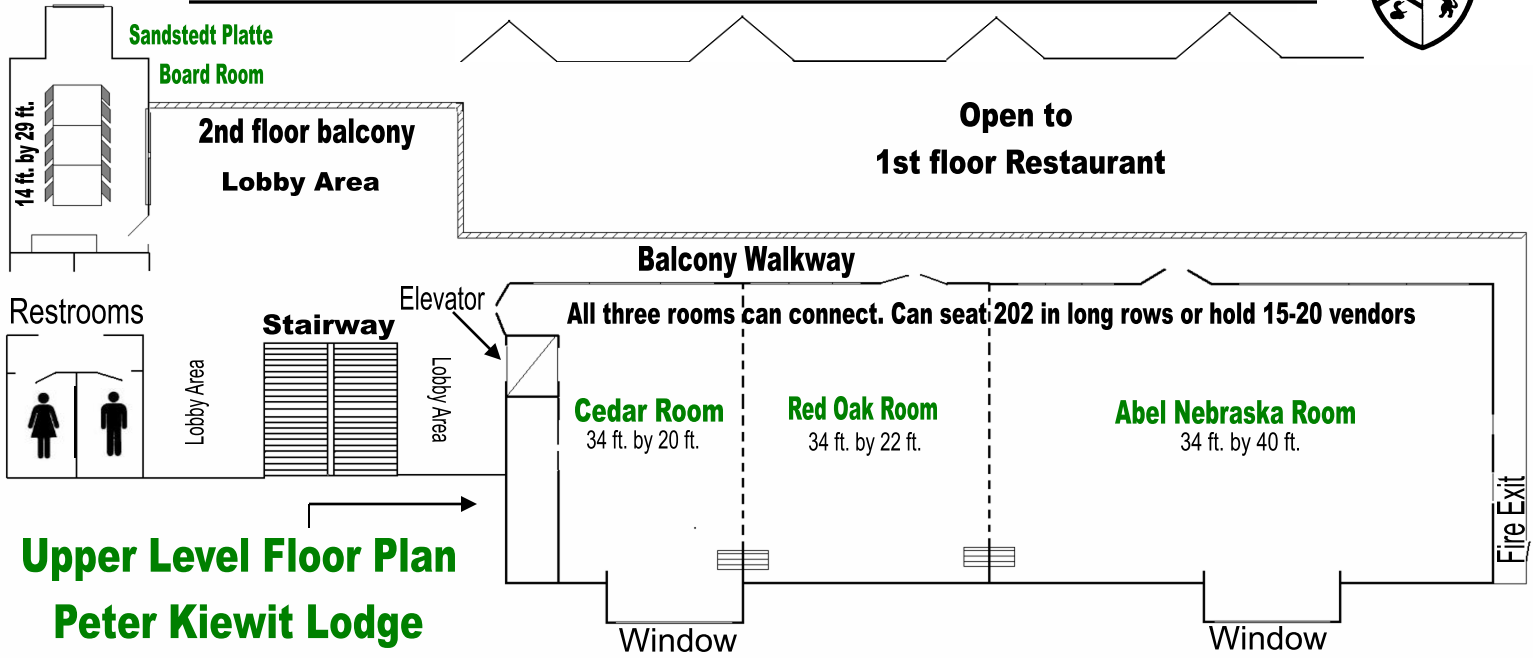
The land for Eugene T. Mahoney State Park was acquired in the spring of 1985. Development of this exceptional park progressed rapidly, with much of the funding coming from private donations to the Nebraska Game and Parks Foundation. Federal grants and state funds also financed development projects. The park opened in May 1991, the first state park in Nebraska designed for year-round operation.

A full deposit request will be made to substantiate confirmation. A *reservation fee will be added (\$8.50 plus tax)*. If numbers increase, an additional fee will be added to the final statement. Extension of the hours will also result in added charges. The deposit is non-refundable unless *advance notice* is given and the facility is rebooked by another group.

Food service costs are in addition to the Pavilion rental cost. Onsite catering is available through the restaurant at Peter Kiewit Lodge; however any outside catering may also be used. It is up to either the caterer or the host to make sure all food and linens are cleaned up on the day of your event.

Although entrance to the **Activity Center** is not included in the rental of the Pavilion, individuals in attendance with a group are welcome to use the center as long as occupancy limits are not exceeded. Established admission charges will apply. The Activity Center is open to the public and will be open during regularly scheduled hours only. If extension of the Activity Center hours is required, then additional charges will apply.

Park Entry Permits are required for each vehicle entering the Park. Individuals may purchase the daily permit upon entering, or the Group Functions staff can set this up with the host as part of the final billing statement.

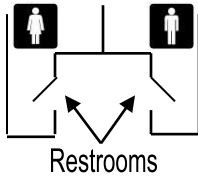
Although parking at the Pavilion/Activity Center is generally adequate, we suggest using buses if applicable. We have **two open-air trams available and a trolley for rental** for hourly fees and they must be requested in advance. They will make continuous tours of the park, stopping at designated spots for loading and unloading guests. *Groups of 250 or more may be required to book the Bur Oak Shelter for additional parking.*

Activity tickets can be provided for your group, including any activities your company would want to pay for. The company will be billed for only the tickets that are turned in at the chosen activity sites. Group Functions will be able to make these arrangements for you.

The Park has tables and chairs to accommodate up to 500 people. Rental arrangements for additional tables and chairs will be setup by the host with a designated time for drop off and pickup in our park. Your Event Coordinator will work with you regarding time schedules and set-up configurations. Outside activities brought into the Park must be approved by a Superintendent.

The Park Staff will handle the trash disposal. We will have trash containers provided for your utilization. Restrooms in the Activity Center are available during regular hours, *however if your group is over 250 people, additional restroom facility rental will be required to accommodate your guests.*

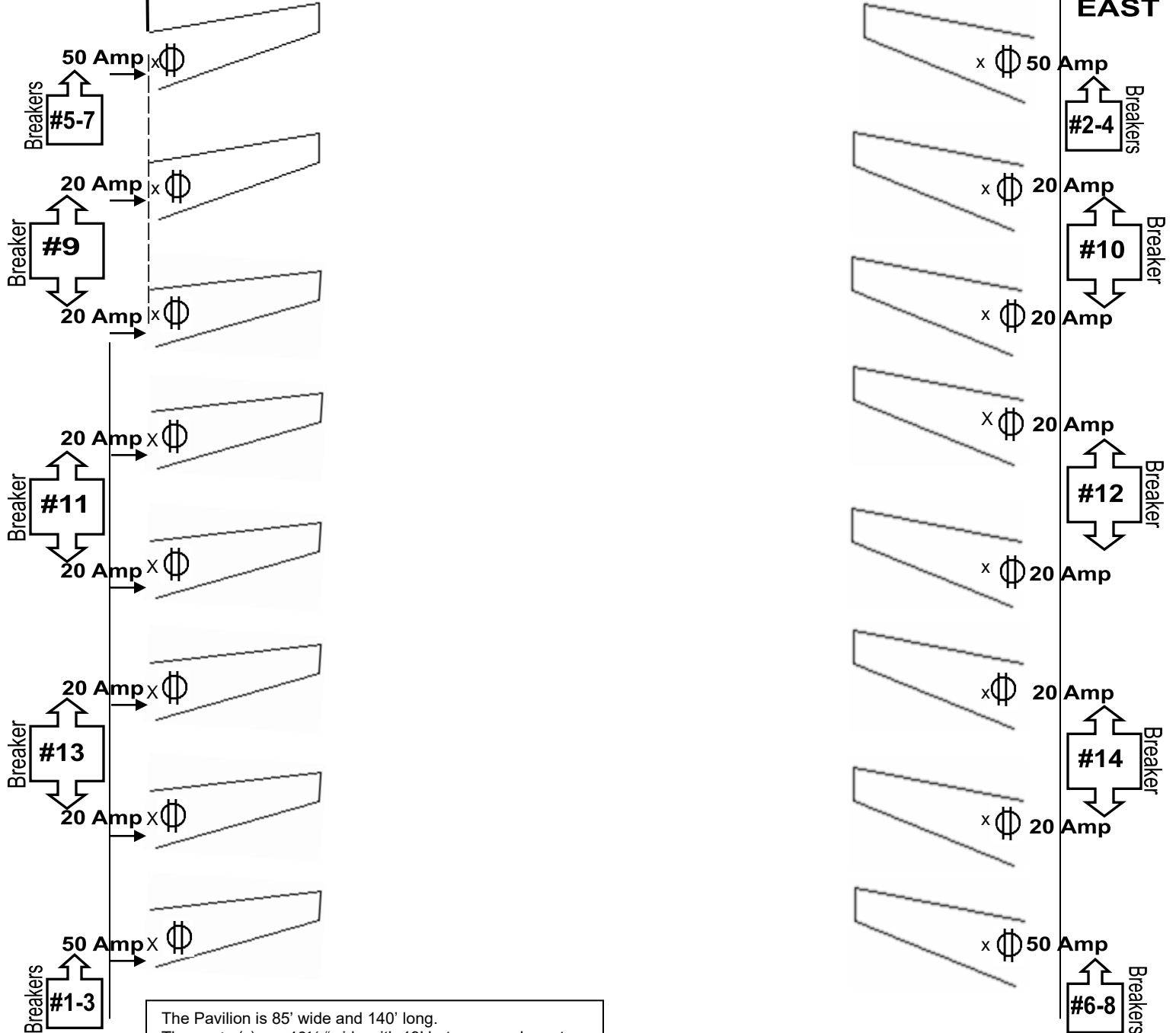

(and others associated with campfires):

- Burn natural wood that has not been painted or treated with any chemicals. (All wood sold in Nebraska state parks is untreated.)
- Burn only wood that can fit within the fire ring. Let nothing overhang or lay outside the ring.
- Limit use of lighter fluid.



- **DO NOT** burn wood containing nails or metal fasteners. No burning of pallets (cut up or otherwise).



- **DO NOT** put cans, bottles (glass or plastic), Styrofoam of any kind, or any other non-burnable materials. Batteries, plastics, metal, foil, cans, plywood, Styrofoam, coated cardboard, and other packing materials have toxic residues and add toxic gases to the smoke.
- Light fires only in designated fires rings or stoves, and keep fires at a manageable size. A small fire is just as enjoyable as a large one, and it will be easier to extinguish.

- Fires should be monitored at all times. Extinguish fire by slowly pouring water over the ash and embers. Be careful, as this will create steam and may cause smoke and ash to rise. Embers covered with dirt or sand can be dangerous because they may continue to burn underground for hours.



- Be careful what you burn. Pressure-treated, or processed wood, which has been treated with a combination of chemicals should never be burned in open fires. This includes plywood, particle board, or any construction materials. When this wood is burned, high concentrations of toxic chemicals, including arsenic, are released in the smoke and remain in the ash. The smoke can be toxic, and the ash that is left behind is hazardous.

Always clean fire rings of any remaining wood and debris. Please be safe and enjoy your camping experience. Thank you for visiting Nebraska's state parks.

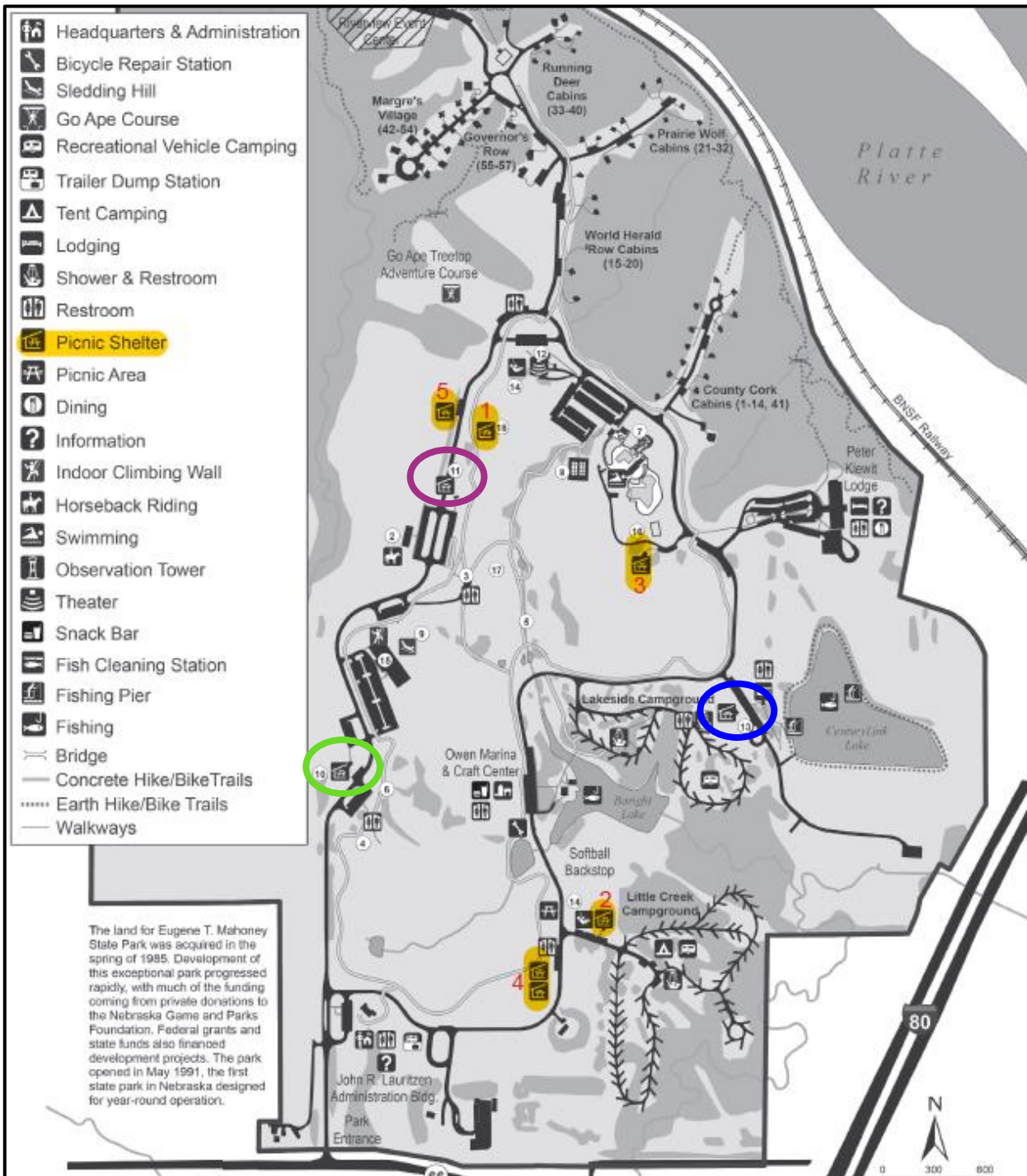

Please note: This park area may not offer all types of campsites. Look for color-coded site markers in your camping area or consult park staff if you have questions about which type of site you are occupying.



FULL HOOKUP - \$35/night

Sites with 20/30/50 amp connections, water and sewer hook-ups, picnic table, fire ring or grill, modern restroom may be available.



ELECTRIC PLUS - \$30/night

Sites with either a 20/30 amp connection with dedicated water hook-up or a 50 amp connection, picnic table, fire ring or grill, primitive or modern restroom may be available.



ELECTRIC - \$25/night

Sites with 20/30 amp connections, picnic table, fire ring or grill, close to hydrant, primitive or modern restroom may be available.



BASIC - \$15/night

Sites without electrical service, but with picnic table, fire ring or grill. Hydrant, trash receptacle, primitive or modern restroom may be located nearby.



PRIMITIVE - \$10/night

Sites without electrical service, picnic table, fire ring or grill; may not have access to restroom facilities or trash receptacle.

EQUESTRIAN - \$5/night Add \$5 per night for sites with equestrian amenities.

Off-season rates: Off-season rates are \$5 less per night for all site types except primitive. Primitive rates are \$10/night year-round.

Cancellation Policy

Conference Rooms and Picnic Shelters

All cancellations for conference rooms and picnic shelters must be submitted in writing *no less than 30 days before the event* to the Group Functions department at ngpc.mahoney.functions@nebraska.gov or the mailing address above.

When the cancellation is received 30 days or more prior to the event, the \$9.40 non-refundable fee plus a \$5.00 cancellation fee (for a total of \$14.40) is charged. The remainder is placed on a voucher. The voucher is good for another event at Mahoney State Park, or can be refunded to the credit card used to make the original payment, or to a check.

Also no less than 30 days before the event, there is the option to transfer your event to a different date without a penalty charged (based on availability).

If the cancellation is made less than 30 days before the event, no refund is granted. If the conference room or shelter was reserved for two or more consecutive nights, the \$14.40 charged, plus the first day of rental. The remainder is placed on voucher.

Lodge Rooms and Cabins

All cancellations for lodge rooms and cabins must be submitted in writing *no less than 30 days before the event* to ngpc.mahoney.reservations@nebraska.gov or the above address. It may also be faxed to 402/944-7604.

Thirty days or more: \$14.40 cancellation fee is charged and the remainder is refunded to the credit card used to make the original payment, or to a check, or is used to make a payment.

Thirty days or less: \$14.40 cancellation fee is charged, plus one night of lodging. Any balance remaining is refunded to the credit card used to make the original payment, or to a check, or is used to make a payment.

This policy applies to all cancellations, including cancellations due to weather. If you have any questions, please contact the Group Functions department at (402) 944-2901.

Facility Rental Policies

Alcohol Policy

*A cash bar must have a licensed provider. A one-page Special Occasion Permit form is required to be submitted at least 30 days prior to the event for approval.

Peter Kiewit Lodge:

- BYOB/Open bar is allowed but no individual bottles or containers larger than 1 gallon (kegs or micro kegs). Service bottles (wine, alcohol for mixed drinks) are permitted.
- Alcoholic drinks must stay in the conference rooms. *Not allowed on sidewalks, grassy areas, parking lot or public spaces (hallways, lobby, couch areas, etc.).*
- All drinking done by 10pm.
- Any alcoholic drinks purchased in the Restaurant must stay in the Restaurant.

Pavilion:

- BYOB/Open bar is allowed but no individual bottles or containers larger than 1 gallon (kegs or micro kegs). Service bottles (wine, alcohol for mixed drinks, etc.) are permitted.
- Alcoholic drinks must stay in the pavilion. *Not allowed on sidewalks, grassy areas, parking lot or public spaces.*
- Last call must be at 7:30pm (for reservations ending at 8:00pm) or 9:30pm (for reservations ending at 10:00pm) to allow guests to finish up and be out of the facility in time.

Riverview Lodge:

- BYOB/Open bar is allowed but no individual bottles or containers larger than 1 gallon (kegs or micro kegs). Service bottles (wine, alcohol for mixed drinks) are permitted.
- Alcoholic drinks must stay inside of the building or on the back patio. *Not allowed on sidewalks, grassy areas, parking lot or public spaces.*
- Last call must be at 9:30pm to allow guests to finish up and be out of the facility in time.

Other:

- Consumption must stay in the facility booked.
- No alcohol is allowed in public buildings/areas such as Activity Center, parking lots, sidewalks, grassy areas, Observation Tower, and swimming areas.
- Consumption is prohibited from 10:00pm-6:00am.

Ice Purchase Policy

***Any unused bags cannot be restocked; therefore, all ice purchases are non-refundable. Those not taken with the group will be disposed of by park staff.**

Peter Kiewit Lodge:

- Ice must be purchased at the PK Lodge Front Desk. Ice bags are stored in the lower level of the PK Lodge. 10 and 20lb bags available.

Pavilion:

- Ice must be purchased through the Group Functions Office prior to the event. 16lb bags available. Ice bags are stored in a locked chest at the Pavilion and transferred to an unlocked deep freezer by Group Functions on the day of the event. If additional bags are needed on the day of the event, the Activity Center staff (or Group Functions if the Activity Center is closed during the event) can get more bags with same day purchase.

Riverview Lodge:

- Ice Machine available in the catering kitchen. There is no additional charge for ice usage. Catering kitchen must be a part of the reservation (full venue rental or additional charge paid for individual room rentals) to access.

Music Policy

Peter Kiewit Lodge:

- No amplified music allowed (DJ, live band, or instruments).
- No dancing is allowed.

Pavilion & Riverview Lodge:

- DJ's or Live band is allowed. However, a one-page Special Occasion Permit form is required to be submitted at least 30 days prior to the event for approval. DJ and band must wrap up at least 30-45 minutes before end of rental period to be able to tear down and be out of the facility by 10:00pm (8:00pm for Open-Air Pavilion).
- Dancing permitted.

Decorations Policy

***All decorations, other than free standing or tabletop, must have prior approval through the Group Functions office.**

Indoors (Peter Kiewit Lodge, Crete Carrier Riverview Lodge)

- Confetti, glitter, rice, fake flower petals, candles (or anything with open flames), sparklers, floating lanterns, balloons, or anything that floats is not allowed.
- Decor items cannot be nailed, screwed, taped, or fastened (push pins, command strips, etc.) to any park structures.

- Begin packing up decorations and personal items at least 30-45 minutes before end of rental period to be able to tear down and be out of the facility by 10:00pm.

Outdoors (Open-Air Pavilion, Picnic Shelters)

- Bird seed and bubbles are allowed. Confetti, glitter, rice, fake flower petals, candles (or anything with open flames), sparklers, floating lanterns, balloons, or anything that floats is not allowed.
- Decor items cannot be nailed, screwed, taped, or fastened (push pins, command strips, etc.) to any park structures.
- Begin packing up decorations and personal items at least 30-45 minutes before end of rental period to be able to tear down and be out of the facility by 10:00pm (8:00pm for Open-Air Pavilion).
